The CDC National Prevention Information Network (NPIN) is the U.S. national reference, referral and distribution service for information on HIV/AIDS, STDs, and TB, sponsored by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The Network maintains a variety of Internet services, including a Web resource, a news update listserv (see below) and an anonymous FTP site. They provide information about HIV/AIDS, sexually transmitted diseases (STDs), and tuberculosis (TB) to people and organizations working in prevention, health care, research, and support services. All of NPIN's services are designed to facilitate the sharing of information about education, prevention, published materials, and research findings and news about HIV/AIDS-, STD-, and TB-related trends.

CDC HIV/STD/TB Prevention News Update provides a synopsis of key scientific articles and lay media reports on HIV/AIDS, other sexually transmitted diseases, and tuberculosis.
