Hello! The most important news is that we have updated mortality status for you and we are providing more standardized information about the R6 Medication Roster. The details below also summarize some smaller changes we've made to the data since the last release. The majority of these smaller changes are the result of users writing to us with questions. Please, if you ever see something that doesn't look right please let us know!

## **Update of mortality status**

We updated livgrad, deathyr, deatmn, xlivsib, xdeatyr, and xdeatmn. These variables now reflect the best information we have through the end of 2019.

## **Medication Roster**

## Minor data corrections

- 1. We discovered inconsistencies in relationship codes between the graduate and sibling versions of the R5 intergenerational transfer module. We corrected the problem for cv017re, cv060re, gv017re, and gv060re.
- 2. We discovered an error in some cases for the R5 measurement of leisure time activities. We archived the incorrect measures and replaced them with a corrected version.
