Table 1 Share of women speakers over time by country

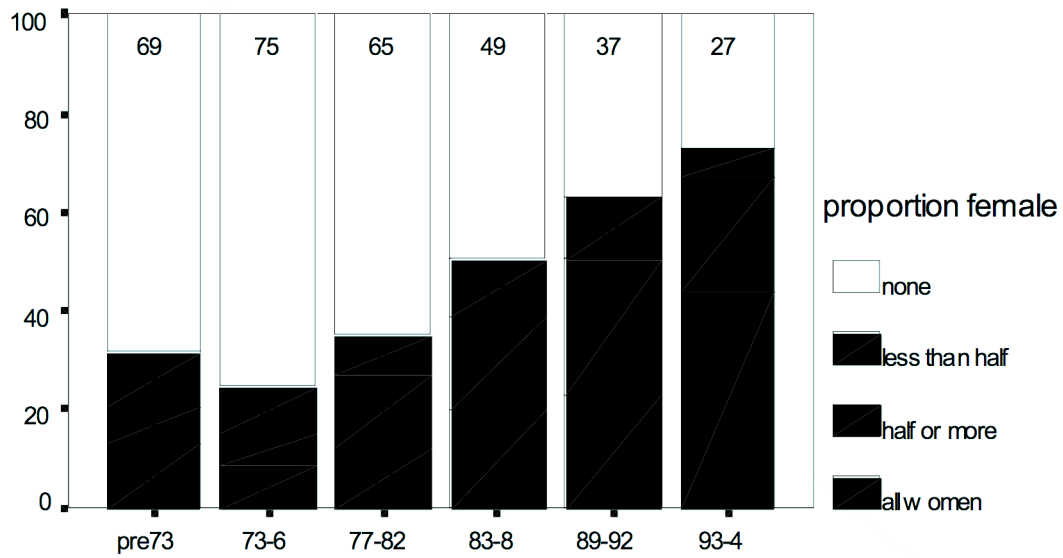

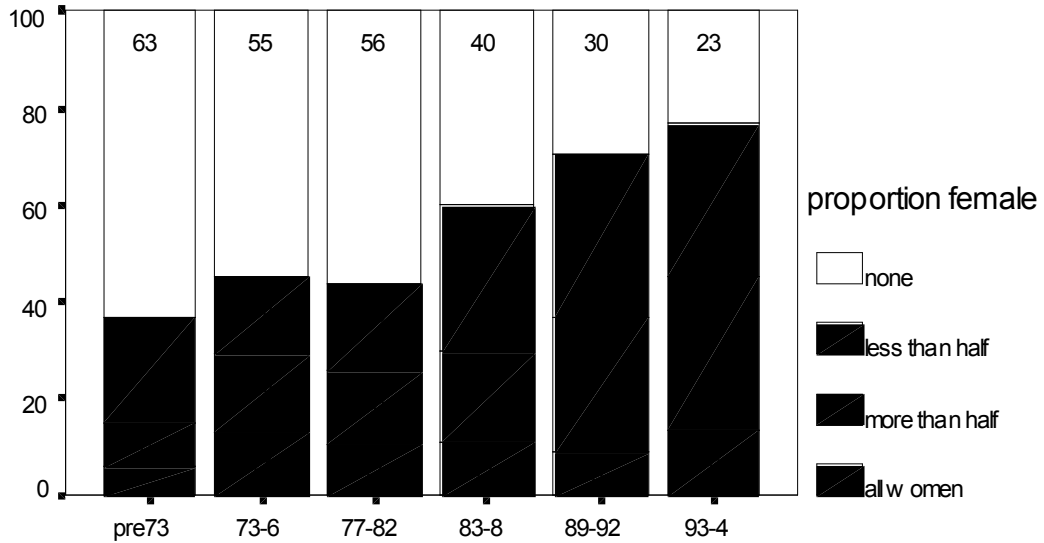

### US: Article composition in terms of gender of speakers

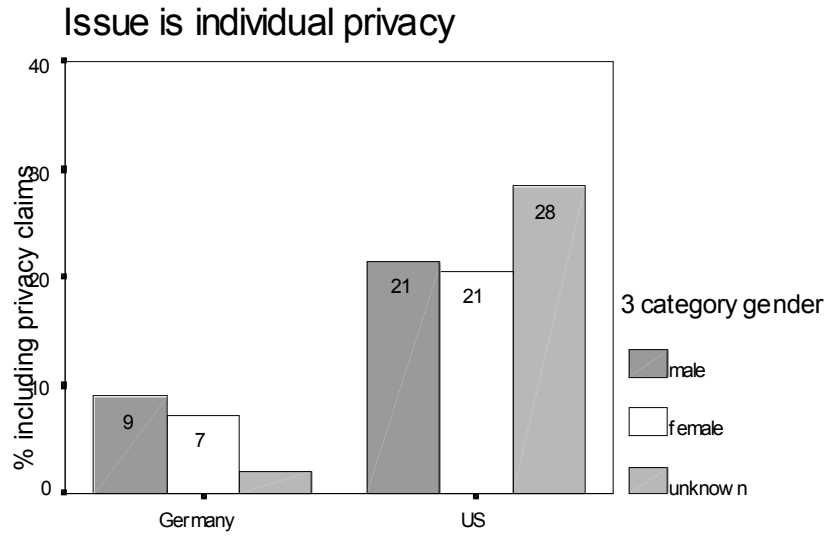

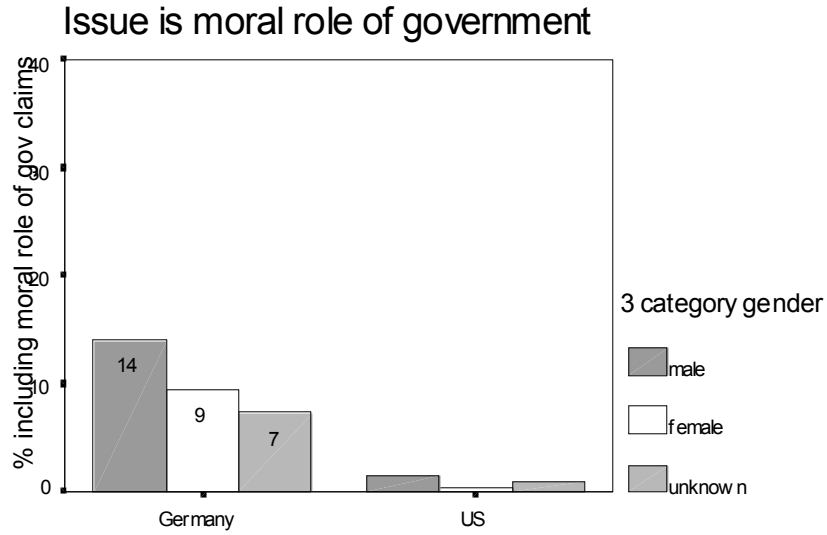

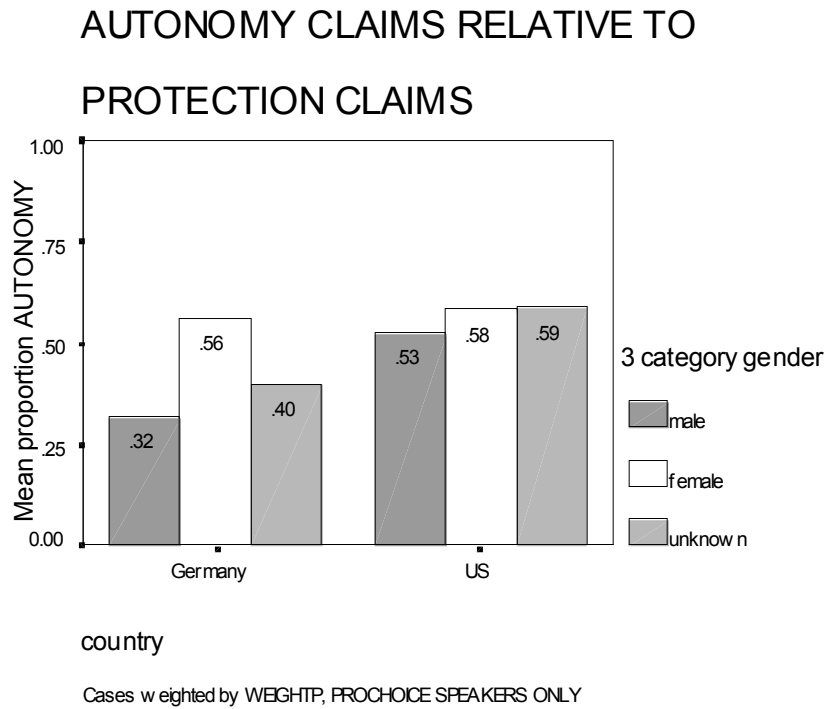
