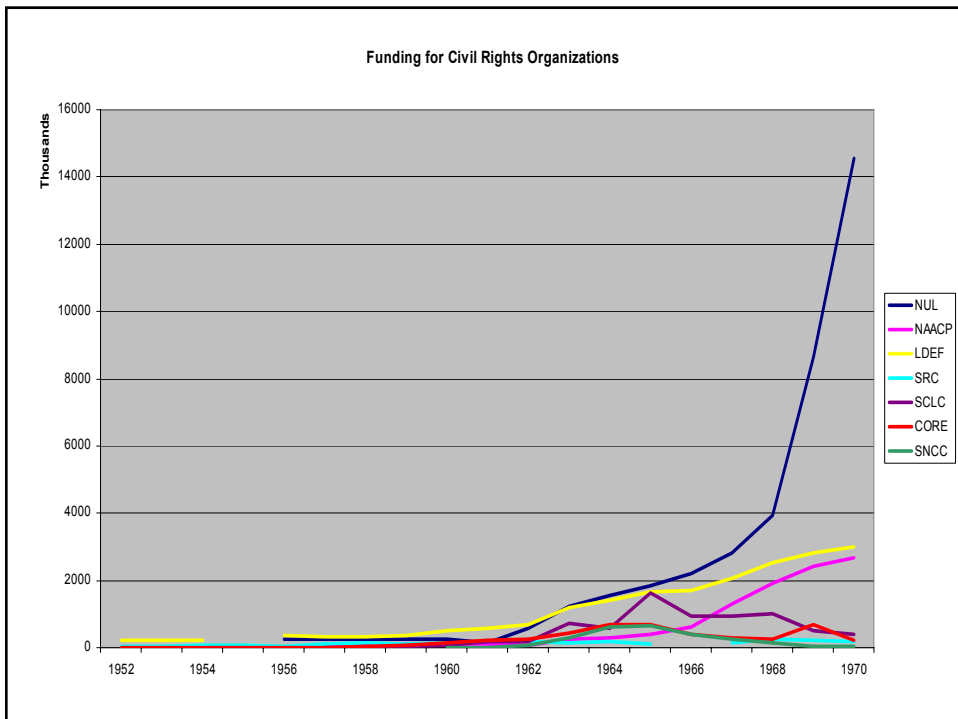
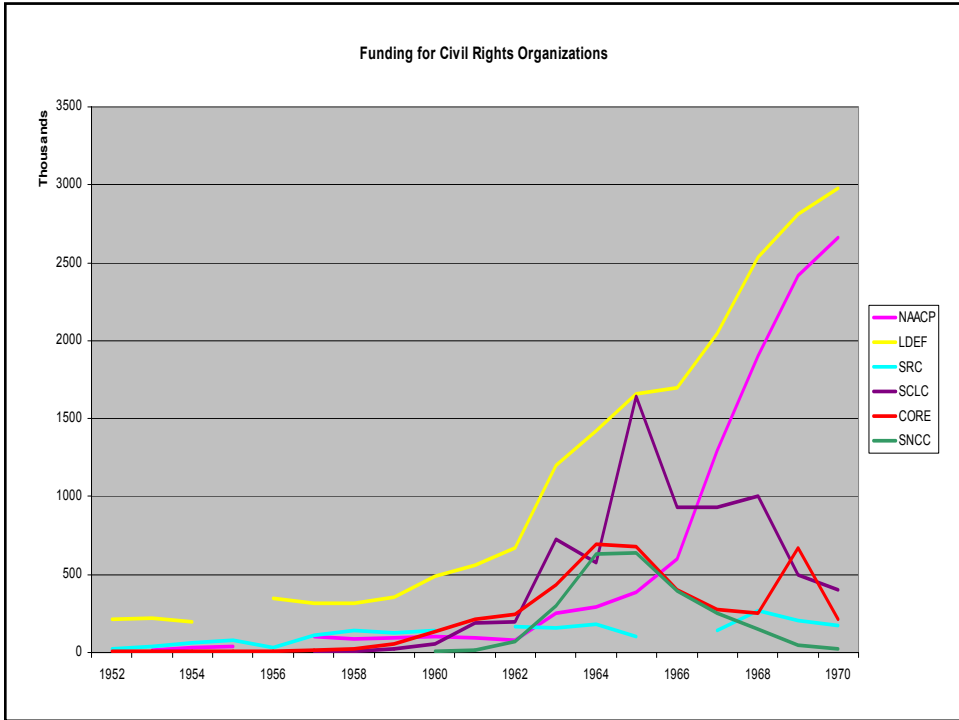

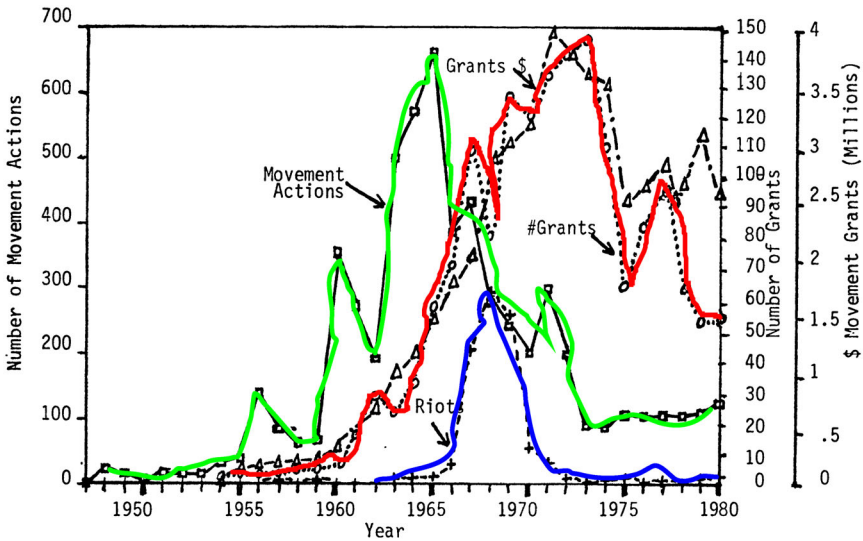

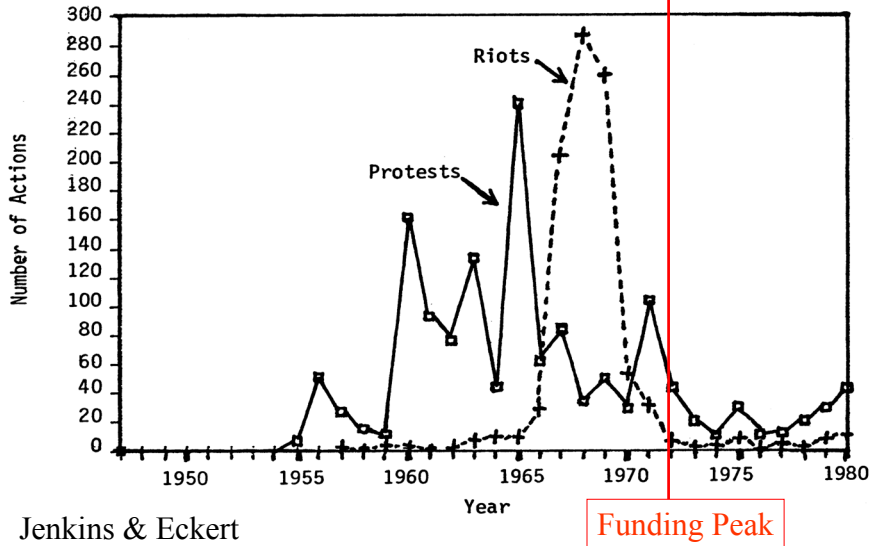
Figure 2. Black Insurgency and Foundation Grants, 1947-80

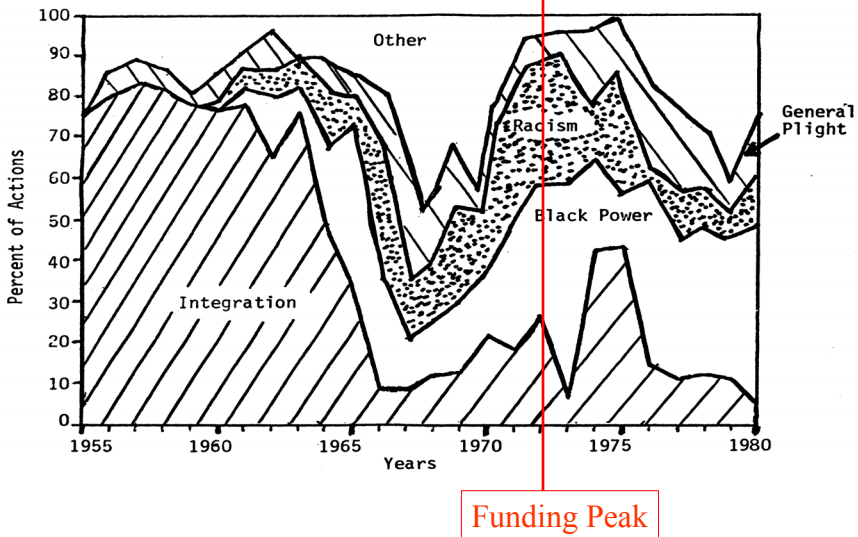
Timing of Black Protests, Riots
